6) Barbara is, once again, forward planning to this year's Christmas Fayre! She is appealing to everyone to save any gift bags they may receive

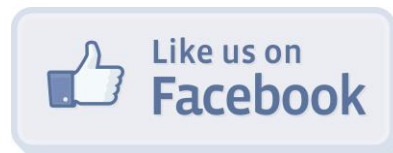
and have no use for. They can be any size – small or large and can be for any occasion. Please hand them to Barbara or into Clark's Pharmacy.
